## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.9

Rep. Bezotte offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare January 11, 2023, as Human Trafficking 2 Awareness Day in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Human trafficking is a modern-day form of slavery 4 involving the illegal trade of people for exploitation or 5 commercial gain; and Whereas, Human trafficking is one of the fastest-growing 6 7 crimes in the world, second only to drug trafficking as the most 8 profitable form of crime, according to the U.S. Department of 9 State; and Whereas, The best estimates indicate that approximately \$87 10 million per day is made off of sex trafficking victims; and 11 12 Whereas, Michigan gained national attention at both the state

- 1 and federal levels after passing effective legislation in 2013 and
- 2 2014 to help combat human trafficking and strengthen victim rights,
- 3 and was named the most improved state in 2015 for its laws
- 4 addressing child sex trafficking, according to Shared Hope
- 5 International. Michigan has gone from a rating of "F" in 2011, to a
- 6 "B" rating in 2019 according to Shared Hope International's
- 7 Protected Innocence Challenge study. While this state has made
- 8 considerable advances in fighting against human trafficking, we all
- 9 must understand that there is still work to be done; and
- 10 Whereas, This legislative body encourages all Michiganders to
- 11 educate themselves about human trafficking and be aware of how
- 12 prevalent it is in our state; and
- 13 Whereas, We support victims of human trafficking who have yet
- 14 to escape or be liberated and offer the gravest concern for those
- 15 who have had loved ones become victims to human trafficking; and
- 16 Whereas, We commend the individuals who have been victims of
- 17 trafficking, survived, and have overcome the atrocity, and continue
- 18 to support all who have dedicated themselves to putting an end to
- 19 human trafficking in Michigan; now, therefore, be it
- 20 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 21 this legislative body declare January 11, 2023, as Human
- 22 Trafficking Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
