## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4818**

August 26, 2025, Introduced by Reps. MacDonell, Price, Weiss, Conlin, Wilson, B. Carter, Arbit, Wegela, Hope, Martus and Paiz and referred to Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1351a (MCL 380.1351a), as amended by 2016 PA 192.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1351a. (1) Beginning with bonds issued after May 1, 1994,
- 2 a school district, including, but not limited to, a school district
- 3 that is a community district or a qualifying school district, shall
- 4 not borrow money and issue bonds of the district under section
- 5 1351(1). However, a school district, including, but not limited to,

- 1 a school district that is a community district, may borrow money
- 2 and issue bonds of the district to defray all or a part of the cost
- 3 of purchasing, erecting, completing, remodeling, or equipping or
- 4 reequipping , except for equipping or reequipping for technology,
- 5 school buildings, including library buildings, structures, athletic
- 6 fields, playgrounds, or other facilities, or parts of or additions
- 7 to those facilities; furnishing or refurnishing new or remodeled
- 8 school buildings; acquiring, preparing, developing, or improving
- 9 sites, or parts of or additions to sites, for school buildings,
- 10 including library buildings, structures, athletic fields,
- 11 playgrounds, or other facilities; purchasing school buses;
- 12 acquiring, installing, or equipping or reequipping school buildings
- 13 for purchasing technology; or accomplishing a combination of the
- 14 purposes set forth in this subsection. Section 1351(2) to (4)
- 15 applies to bonds issued under this section.
- 16 (2) The proceeds of bonds issued under this section or under
- 17 section 11i of the state school aid act of 1979, MCL 388.1611i,
- 18 shall be used for capital expenditures and to pay costs of bond
- 19 issuance, and shall not be used for maintenance costs. Except as
- 20 otherwise provided in this subsection, a school district that
- 21 issues bonds under this section or under section 11i of the state
- 22 school aid act of 1979, MCL 388.1611i, shall have an independent
- 23 audit, using generally accepted accounting principles, of its
- 24 bonding activities under these sections conducted within 120 days
- 25 after completion of all projects financed by the proceeds of the
- 26 bonds and shall submit the audit report to the department of
- 27 treasury. For bonds issued under section 11i of the state school
- 28 aid act of 1979, MCL 388.1611i, the independent audit required
- 29 under this subsection may be conducted and submitted with the

- annual report required under the revised municipal finance act,
  2001 PA 34, MCL 141.2101 to 141.2821.
- 3 (3) A school district, including, but not limited to, a school
- 4 district that is a community district, shall not borrow money and
- 5 issue notes or bonds under this section to defray all or part of
- 6 the costs of any of the following:
- 7 (a) Upgrades to operating system or application software.
- 8 (b) Media, including diskettes, compact discs, video tapes,
- 9 and disks, unless used for the storage of initial operating system
- 10 software or customized application software included in the
- 11 definition of technology under this section.
- 12 (c) Training, consulting, maintenance, service contracts,
- 13 software upgrades, troubleshooting, or software support.
- 14 (a) Consumables, including storage media, ink, toner, or
- 15 batteries.
- 16 (b) Repair of end-user devices that are outside of the
- 17 initially purchased warranty.
- 18 (c) Curriculum-specific software or training in the use of
- 19 curriculum-specific software.
- 20 (4) A resident of a school district, including, but not
- 21 limited to, a school district that is a community district, has
- 22 standing to bring suit against the school district to enforce the
- 23 provisions of this section in a court having jurisdiction.
- 24 (5) As used in this section, "technology" means any of the
- 25 following:
- 26 (a) Hardware and communication devices that transmit, receive,
- 27 or compute information for pupil instructional purposes.
- (b) The initial purchase of operating system software or
- 29 customized application software, or both, accompanying the purchase

- 1 of hardware and communication devices under subdivision (a).
- 2 (c) The costs of design and installation of the hardware,
- 3 communication devices, and initial operating system software or
- 4 sustomized application software authorized under this subsection.
- 5 (a) Hardware, software, cloud-hosted software as a service,
- 6 technological infrastructure, software licenses, software support
- 7 and warranties, and relevant consulting in the use of hardware and
- 8 software.
- 9 (b) Technological equipment management, building systems
- 10 management, cybersecurity, physical security, and voice
- 11 communication software.
- 12 (c) Relevant consulting in cybersecurity.
- 13 (d) The design, installation, or operation of any hardware,
- 14 software, communication device, operating system software, or
- 15 customized application software authorized under this section.
