

MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENTS
Act 327 of 1965

AN ACT to set certain minimum standards for fire departments in certain municipalities; and to provide a time within which they must comply.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

123.831 Fire departments in cities of 70,000; minimum standards.

Sec. 1. In each city, township or village which has or shall hereafter attain a population of 70,000 or more according to the last decennial census, the fire department shall meet the minimum standards set by the Michigan inspection bureau to qualify for class 6 fire classification.

123.832 Time within which standards must be met.

Sec. 2. These minimum standards shall be met within 1 year from the effective date of this act or within 1 year from the date the municipality attains a population of 70,000 or more.
