

MARRIAGE OF INDIVIDUALS UNDER EIGHTEEN
Act 352 of 1921

AN ACT to prohibit the marriage of an individual under 18 years of age.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

551.51 Age of consent; effect of act on powers of probate judge.

Sec. 1. (1) A marriage in this state shall not be contracted by an individual who is under 18 years of age. A marriage, if entered into in this state by an individual under 18 years of age, is void.

(2) This section applies to a marriage entered into on or after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this subsection.
