

MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)
Act 116 of 1954

168.76 Secretary of state and attorney general; election.

Sec. 76. A secretary of state and attorney general shall be elected at the general election in 1964, 1966, and every fourth year thereafter.
