

COUNTY ZONING ACT (EXCERPT)
Act 183 of 1943

125.219 County board of appeals; meetings; oaths; compelling attendance of witnesses; conducting business at public meeting; notice of meeting; record of proceedings; availability of record and other writings to public.

Sec. 19. (1) Meetings of the board of appeals shall be held at the call of the chairperson and at other times as the board in its rules of procedure may specify. The chairperson, or in the chairperson's absence the acting chairperson, may administer oaths and compel the attendance of witnesses. The business which the board of appeals may perform shall be conducted at a public meeting of the board of appeals held in compliance with Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. Public notice of the time, date, and place of the meeting shall be given in the manner required by Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976.

(2) The board shall maintain a record of its proceedings which shall be filed in the office of the county clerk. The record and any other writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the board in the performance of an official function shall be made available to the public in compliance with Act No. 442 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 15.231 to 15.246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
