## MENTAL HEALTH CODE (EXCERPT) Act 258 of 1974

## 330.1475a Hospitalization without hearing; objection.

Sec. 475a.

- (1) If an individual is hospitalized without a hearing after placement in an assisted outpatient treatment program, the individual has a right to object to the hospitalization. Upon transfer of the individual to the hospital, the hospital shall notify the individual of his or her right to object under this section.
- (2) Upon receipt of an objection to a hospitalization under subsection (1), the court shall schedule a hearing for a determination that the individual requires hospitalization.
