

STATE CONSTITUTION (EXCERPT)
CONSTITUTION OF MICHIGAN OF 1963

Â§ 7 Boards of supervisors; members.

Sec. 7.

A board of supervisors shall be established in each organized county consisting of one member from each organized township and such representation from cities as provided by law.

History: Const. 1963, Art. VII, Â§ 7, Eff. Jan. 1, 1964
