

HISTORY OF INITIATIVE PETITIONS IN THE HOUSE

Initiative petition: an initiation of Legislation to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled “An act to make appropriations to aid in the support of the public schools and the intermediate school districts of the state; to make appropriations for certain other purposes relating to education; to provide for the disbursement of the appropriations; to supplement the school aid fund by the levy and collection of certain taxes; to authorize the issuance of certain bonds and provide for the security of those bonds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments, the state board of education, and certain other boards and officials; to create certain funds and provide for their expenditure; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.”

Initiative petition: an initiation of legislation to repeal 1975 PA 228, entitled “Single business tax act,” (MCL 208.1 to 208.145); to provide for the collection of taxes due under current law on business activity in this state through December 31, 2007; and to encourage the legislature to adopt a tax that is less burdensome and less costly to employers, and more conducive to job creation and investment.
